

RWSI "Salute to Excellence" Awards – 2017

RWSI presents seven "Salute to Excellence" awards yearly, recognizing outstanding achievement in the civil helicopter industry. The winners will receive their awards at the "Salute to Excellence" awards celebration, to be held on November 2017, during Heli Power India 2017, in New Delhi. For these Awards, Acts of Excellence performed up to 31 March 2016 will qualify.

(i) RWSI Humanitarian Service Award: This Award honours Armed forces Helicopter (Army, Navy, Air Force & Coast Guard) Units which have saved precious lives through their deed in life threatening situations with their outstanding professionalism & courage. Armed Forces Headquarters will nominate the Helicopter Units for the Award. (ii) HAL Safety Award: This award honours Individual pilot / AME in achieving highest Safety Standards while operating HAL manufactured helicopter either in Civil or Military Aviation. To qualify for the award the nominee must be an employee of a Helicopter Company / Helicopter Unit/ Squadron of any of the armed forces. (iii) Igor I Sikorsky Award: for pioneering work in the field of rotary wing aviation in India:- The award is given to a helicopter professional (Military/ Civil) who has made major pioneering contribution to the growth of Indian Helicopter Industry. (iv) RWSI Pilot Safety Award: The Pilot Safety Award honours pilots in civil who have achieved at least 10,000 consecutive helicopter flight hours free of accidents or violations as PIC. The award recognizes a pilot's overall flight safety record, recognizing civilian flight hours. To qualify, the pilot must be an employee of a Helicopter Company who is Corporate Member of RWSI or Life Member of RWSI. (v) RWSI Aircraft Maintenance Engineer Safety Award: The AME Safety Award honours helicopter maintenance engineers in India who have fifteen or more years of violation-free professional helicopter maintenance experience. To qualify, the applicant AME must be either an employee of a Helicopter Company who is Corporate Member of RWSI or Life Member of RWSI. (vi) RWSI award for outstanding achievements in the Civil Helicopter Industry: The award is given to a helicopter professional, who has made outstanding contribution to the civil helicopter industry. (vii) Life Time Achievement Award: The award is given to a helicopter professional, to recognize contributions made by him/her over the whole of a career to the Industry, rather than or in addition to single contributions.
